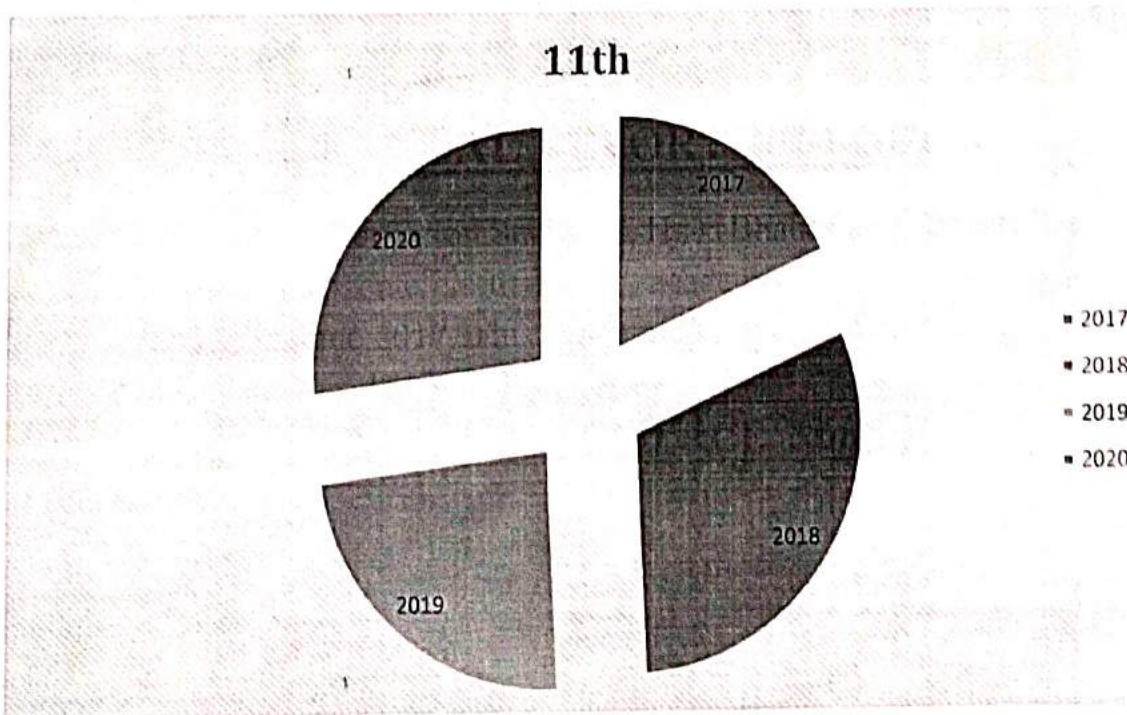

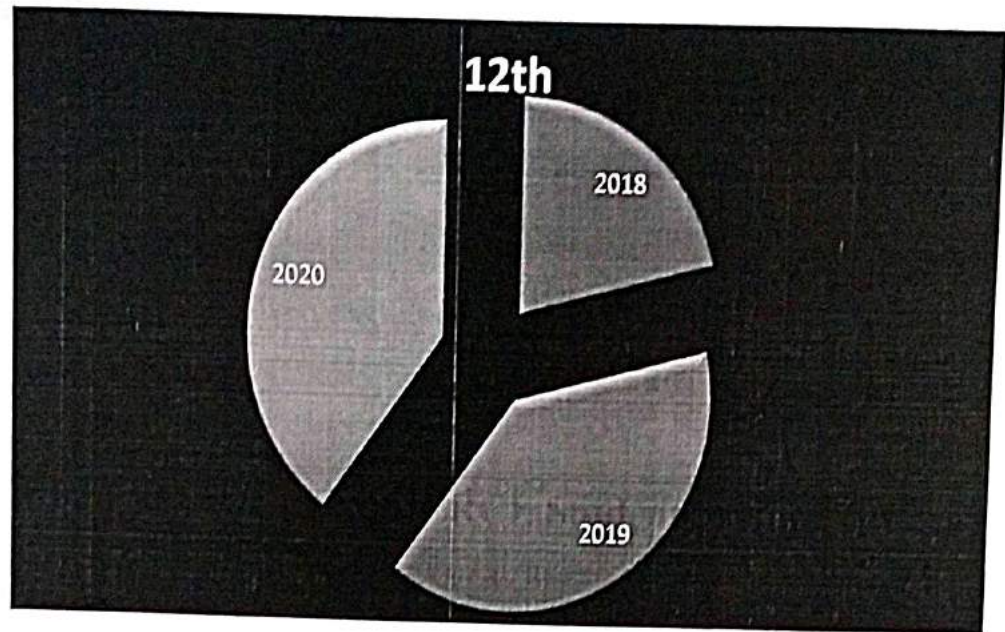
ANNUAL REPORT 2019-2020

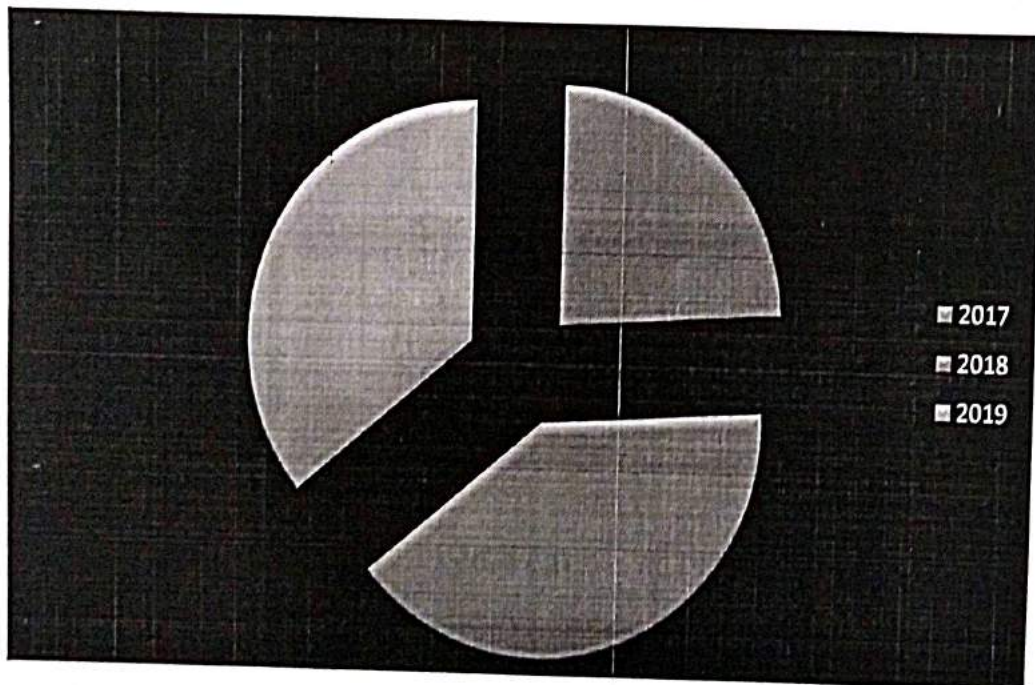
- **Strength of XI Std. COMMERCE Students: (since 2017 to 2020);**
